Schirtzinger Road Construction Update

Dear Neighbor,

This letter has been prepared in association with the Norwich Township Trustees to keep you informed of the status of the Schirtzinger Road storm sewer and road maintenance project.

The installation of a new natural gas supply line by the Columbia Gas Company has been completed and residential service is now being transferred to the new main line. This work should be finished by early October.

The Franklin County Engineer's Bridge and Utility Maintenance Department, which had started the initial installation of new storm sewer pipe and catch basins in early August, will resume their work once the gas lines are safely resituated.

Storm sewer and berm construction, and landscape repairs will proceed until their completion in mid-December, weather permitting.

The final repair and resurfacing of Schirtzinger Road, by the Kokosing Construction Company, will occur next spring.

Local access to homes within the construction area, from Dublin Road to north of Ravenwood Drive, will continue to be maintained. Through traffic, however, will be detoured as required by some phases of construction. The posted detour route will use Dublin Road and Davidson Road.

Thank you for your patience and understanding of our efforts to improve Schirtzinger Road. Please drive cautiously around our work site for everyone's safety.
